

Household Minor Works Validation Scheme

Building owners have the responsibility for ensuring the safety of their buildings and be free of unauthoised building works.

Before the full implementation of the Minor Works Control System on 31.12.2010, many minor structures for amenities such as supporting frames for air-conditioners, drying racks and small canopies had been built without the approval of the Buildings Department (BD).


If these unauthoised structures fall down and cause injuries to persons or damage to properties, building owners will be legally liable. To avoid such accidents, building owners should remove these unauthoised structures as soon as possible. If you want to retain them, you have to ensure they are safe and you may join the Household Minor Works Validation Scheme. Under the validation scheme, these unauthoised structures for amenities can be retained for continued use after inspection, strengthening (if necessary) and certification of their structural safety by registered building professionals and / or registered contractors.

Structures eligible for joining the Household Minor Works Validation Scheme are the "prescribed building or building works" (or "PB/BW") with their criteria specified in Schedule 3 of the Building (Minor Works) Regulation.

| Item | The prescribed building or building works | |

| 1. | Unauthorised supporting structure for an air-conditioning unit, water cooling tower or any associated air duct On-grade or on a slab (not cantilevered) Weight of the cooling plant ≤ 100kg | Weight ≤ 100kg |
| 2. | Unauthorised metal supporting frame for an air-conditioning unit or any associated duct Projection ≤ 600mm Weight of the cooling plant ≤ 100kg No projection over street or common part of building if the highest point of frame ≤ 3m from ground | Weight ≤ 100kg |
| 3. | Unauthorised drying rack Projection ≤ 750mm No projection over street or common part of building if the highest point of rack ≤ 3m from ground | Projection ≤ 750mm |
| 4. | Unauthorised canopy Projection ≤ 500mm No concrete No projection over street or common part of building if the highest point of canopy ≤ 3m from ground | Projection ≤ 500mm |

Enforcement action by the issue of a removal order or a warning notice under the Buildings Ordinance (BO) will not be taken by the BD against the validated building or building works on the ground that they have been completed or carried out without prior approval and consent. Notwithstanding, the status of the validated building or building works is still unauthoised building works.
