1. I have been appointed to provide supervision for the safe erection of the temporary structures and compliance with building safety requirements under Appendix 8 of "A Guide to Application for Places of Public Entertainment Licences for Places Other Than Cinemas and Theatres" issued by the Food and Environmental Hygiene Department for the TPPEL in support of the TPPEL application detailed in Part A.
2. I have examined the relevant structural justifications (SJ) of the PTS to be reused/re-erected at the pre-accepted location(s) for the TPPEL application as specified in Part B with PTS registration number indicated in the attached layout plan. I certify the following:
 - (a) The design codes and standards adopted in the accepted SJ kept under the PTS Register are still applicable;
 - (b) The PTS are maintained in sound condition and have the adequate structural strength to take up the design loads;
 - (c) The PTS have no adverse effect on the integrity of the existing structures;
 - (d) The period for which PTS are required would not be longer than that adopted in the accepted SJ kept under the PTS Register (applicable for outdoor temporary structures only); and
 - (e) The PTS would be erected in the pre-accepted location(s) and in accordance with the structural details set out in the accepted SJ kept under PTS Register.

I understand that if I provide information that is false or misrepresenting a material fact or furnish the Building Authority, an authorized officer or a public officer with information knowing that it is false or misrepresenting a material fact in this certificate, I shall render myself liable to disciplinary action under section 7 of the Buildings Ordinance (Cap. 123) and/or other legal action. ^[Note 2]

The PTS to be reused/re-erected should be those in the PTS Register of the Buildings Department. A list of the PTS and guidelines for inclusion in the PTS Register are accessible from Buildings Department website www.bd.gov.hk for reference by the public and the practitioners.

Any person making a false declaration or misrepresenting a material fact shall be guilty of a criminal offence and subject to prosecution.

A. Personal Data

Purposes of Collection
