Under the Comprehensive Building Safety Improvement Loan Scheme, loan applications are rejected mainly because of the applicants' not meeting the loan eligibility criteria or failing to provide the necessary information for consideration. Apart from financial assistance under the above loan scheme, the Buildings Department also offers social service assistance to building owners in need as and when necessary. Such work will be outsourced to non-government social service organisations at an estimated cost of \$5.2 million for 2008-09.
