Question:

The Financial Secretary stated in paragraph 148 of the 2015-16 Budget Speech that “I asked all policy bureaux to achieve more efficient use of resources through re-engineering and re-prioritising. I have also launched the "0-1-1" envelope savings programme to reduce operating expenditure by a total of two per cent over the next three financial years. Resources saved will be re-allocated for new services.” Please inform this Committee how the Buildings Department will implement the "0-1-1" envelope savings programme in 2015-16, 2016-17 and 2017-18, the services affected and the details of the expenditure involved.

Reply:

Under the “0-1-1” envelope savings programme, bureaux are requested to deliver 1% savings on their respective annual operating expenditure in 2016-17 and 2017-18. The primary purpose is to encourage bureaux and departments to enhance productivity and effectiveness in the use of resources through greater efforts in re-engineering and re-prioritisation. The savings achieved could be released for internal re-distribution towards the provision of new and improved public services.

The estimate for the Buildings Department (BD) for 2016-17 is higher than that for 2015-16 by 3.3%, reflecting that efficiency savings achieved through the “0-1-1” programme and new resources have been allocated to the BD for delivering new/improved services.
