Question:

In connection with industrial buildings (domestic), please provide the numbers of inspections, prosecutions and tenants involved, as well as court convictions and tenants involved in the past five years, broken down by district.

Reply:

Insofar as premises (including sub-divided flats) used for domestic purpose in industrial buildings (IBs) are concerned, apart from responding to reports, the Buildings Department (BD) has been taking enforcement actions to eradicate such premises in an orderly and systematic manner through large scale operations since April 2012. The BD does not compile statistics on the number of tenants involved in prosecution and conviction cases. Information on the geographical distribution of premises inspected in IBs, prosecutions instigated against failure to comply with removal orders or discontinuation orders, and convictions for the past five years is set out below -
