Please list the number and names of target buildings involved, broken down by the 18 districts. What are the changes in the target buildings, the staff establishment for the LSO and the estimated expenditure as compared with the past three years?

Reply:

In 2018, the Buildings Department (BD) will mount large scale operation (LSO) on comprehensive clearance of unauthorised building works (UBWs) on rooftops, flat roofs, yards and lanes in 80 target buildings. Disclosure of the list of target buildings may affect the enforcement action that will be taken by BD. It is therefore inappropriate to disclose the names of the target building that will be involved in the 2018-19 LSO.

The numbers of target buildings under the aforesaid LSO in the past three years and 2018 are tabulated as follows –

The LSO will be carried out by the professional and technical staff of the two Existing Buildings Divisions (EBDs) of BD as part of their overall duties to implement BD's building safety and maintenance enforcement programmes.
