Reply:

The Buildings Department (BD) takes enforcement action against unauthorised building works (UBWs) on rooftops in response to public reports and through its large scale operations. BD does not compile statistics on the number of tenants involved in prosecution and conviction cases or maintain separate statistics on the number of inspections made in connection with rooftop UBWs. The geographical distribution of prosecution and conviction cases in connection with non-compliance with removal orders for rooftop UBWs from January 2013 to December 2017 is as follows –
