The Buildings Department does not compile statistics on the number of sub-divided flats in industrial buildings, squatters, rooftop structures and "capsule-like accommodation".

Separately, according to the Long Term Housing Strategy (LTHS) promulgated in 2014, the Government updates the long term housing demand projection annually and presents a rolling ten-year housing supply target. A major demand component in the housing demand projection is the housing demand arising from inadequately housed households.
