### Question:

Please provide the numbers of sub-divided flats (SDFs) inspected by the Buildings Department, SDFs with building irregularities identified, SDFs with irregularities rectified, removal orders and closure orders issued in relation to building irregularities associated with those SDFs, non-compliant cases, prosecutions instigated and convictions in each of the past five years.

### Reply:

Enforcement against building irregularities associated with sub-divided flats (SDFs) is carried out through large scale operations and by acting on complaints/reports. Statistics on the numbers of SDFs inspected, SDFs with building irregularities identified, SDFs rectified of building irregularities, removal orders issued and closure orders applied from the court in relation to building irregularities associated with SDFs, outstanding removal orders, prosecutions instigated against non-compliance with removal orders and convictions in the past five years are tabulated below –
