

Display of Site Information

To enable members of the public to bring to the attention of registered contractors (RC) any undesirable or unsafe conditions on building sites, you are requested to provide relevant information to facilitate contact. It is desirable that the following information be displayed in a prominent position on site for public information :

- a) Address and/or lot number of the site;
- b) Names of authorized person, registered structural engineer and RC;
- c) Contact telephone number(s).

2. While display of advertisement is not permitted on any hoarding or covered walkway, there is no objection under Building (Planning) Regulation 66(4) for the display of the basic development information such as proposed works, use, height, number of blocks and the anticipated project completion date.

3. For information displayed in locations other than the hoarding and covered walkway, you should ensure that such information is displayed within lot boundaries and does not interfere with the site activities.

4. A similar practice note has been issued to authorized persons and registered structural engineers.
