Summary of Decisions of the Building Committee Building Committee I 43/2004 held on 3.11.2004

(a) MAI 1 43/2004

Issue : Proposed change in use from office to hotel for a 27-storey

commercial/office building.

Decision : The committee accepted the integrated A/C system which had been

accepted in other projects. The committee required further information on the central hot water system for consideration. The committee also decided that BOH for the purpose of exclusion from

GFA, should be clearly demarcated on the plans.

(b) <u>BCI 1 43/2004</u>

Issue : Proposed change in use from office to guesthouse for a 25-storey

commercial building.

Decision : The committee rejected the proposed change in use in view of the

adverse comment from Transport Department and non-compliance with

the criteria set out in PNAP 111.

(c) <u>BCI 2 43/2004</u>

Issue : Proposed voids over the living areas of duplex units at 2/F for a

low-rise residential development.

Decision : The committee accepted that the proposal was a hybrid development

akin to a house development and resembled the Tai Po Kau case that accepted by the BAC. Taking into consideration the AP's

justification, the committee accepted the proposal.

(d) <u>BCI 3 43/2004</u>

Issue : Proposed footbridge to be projected over the public pavement.

Decision : The committee noted that the proposed footbridge link would be open

for public circulation and accepted that the proposal would be of mutual benefit to the public and the owners. The committee accepted the proposal subject to compliance with Transport Department and

Highways Department's requirements.
