Summary of Decisions of the Building Committee Building Committee I 6/2005 held on 8.2.2005

(a) MAI 1 6/2005

Issue : Proposed change in use from office to guesthouse house from 6/F to

23/F.

Decision : The committee did not accept the proposed change in use as the

provision of the central A/C and hot water had not been clearly

demarcated on plans.

(b) BCI 1 6/2005

Issue : Proposed circulation staircase between the two flats resulting in a

breach of the condition of exemption on the size of the balcony under

the JPNs.

Decision : The committee did not accept the proposal on the ground of

contravention of the condition set out in the JPNs.

(c) BCI 2 6/2005

Issue : Proposed 3-storey single-family house with a basement without the

provision of a service lane.

Decision : Having noted that there was no existing lane pattern in vicinity and

the nature of the development, the committee accepted the proposal.

(d) BCI 3 6/2005

Issue : Proposed change in use from office to hotel from 5/F to 26/F.

Decision : The committee, having noted that the proposal was a genuine hotel

and was in compliance with the requirements set out in PNAP 111,

accepted the proposed change in use.

(e) <u>BCI 4 6/2005</u>

Issue : Review of the granting of hotel concession in view of adverse

comments from outside department.

Decision : The committee invited the officials of the relevant department to

attend the BC meeting.

(f) BCI 5 6/2005

Issue : Excessive floor height of the fover of an office building.

Decision : The committee, having considered the design and nature of the

common foyer, accepted the proposal.
