Summary of Decisions of the Building Committee Building Committee I 13/2005 held on 12.4.2005

(a) BCI 1 13/2005

Issue : Proposed change in use from shop to hotel/guesthouse.

Decision : The committee noted that the proposed hotel/guesthouse did not

comply with the requirements set out in the PNAP 111 and did not

agree the proposed change in use.

(b) BCI 2 13/2005

Issue : Proposed 30-storey hotel building with excessive site coverage.

Decision : As the proposal was designed in accordance with PNAP 280, the

committee agreed to grant a modification for the excessive site

coverage.

(c) <u>BCI 3 13/2005</u>

Issue : Proposed change in use of a number of shops in shopping arcade to

residential care home for the elderly (RCHE).

Decision : The committee noted that the proposed RCHE was not provided with

natural lighting and ventilation and did not have proper fire separation with the adjoining uses. Hence the proposed conversion would not be acceptable under s25 of the BO and the committee agreed to

prohibit the proposed change in use.

(d) <u>BCI 4 13/2005</u>

Issue : Proposed surrender for lane widening in return for bonus PR and SC

granted for a composite building.

Decision : The committee noted that the proposed surrender would bring the lane

to a uniform width. The committee accepted the proposed surrender

subject to acceptance of the same by CES/A, LandsD.

(e) <u>BCI 5 13/2005</u>

Issue : Proposed signboard with a display area of about 162m² projecting

over street

Decision : The committee was of the view that the size of the signboard was

excessive and did not accept the proposal.
