Summary of Decisions of the Building Committee Building Committee I 23/2006 held on 6.6.2006

(a) MAI 1 23/2006

Issue : Exclusion of lift shaft at G/F and the Integrated Entrance from GFA

calculations.

Decision : The committee, noted that the provision of the disabled lift for access

to the proposed public passage solely for access to the MTR station was in public interest. Hence, the committee agreed to exclude the lift and the associated Integrated Entrance from GFA calculation

subject to no objection from LandsD.

(b) MAI 2 23/2006

Issue : (i) Conversion of an existing non-domestic building into hotel with hotel concession under B(P)Reg 23A.

(ii) Existing service lane of 2.42m wide at the rear.

Decision : (i) The committee, having noted that TD had no objection to the

non-provision of on-site transport facilities and that the proposal was in compliance with the requirements set out in PNAP 111, agreed to grant hotel concession under B(P)Reg

23A.

(ii) The committee, noting the existing site condition, accepted the

service lane under B(P)R 28.

(c) <u>BCI 1 23/2006</u>

Issue : Proposed wall signboard projecting over lane.

Decision : The committee, having noted that the proposed sign did not comply

with the requirements set out in PNAP 269, agreed not to grant

exemption for the wall signboard to project over the existing lane.

(d) BCI 2 23/2006

Issue : Proposed wall signboards and cladding projecting over street and

substantial wall signboard and cladding.

Decision: The committee, having studied the plans, agreed (i) to grant

exemption for the wall signboard to project over street provided that it was solely used for displaying advertisement; and (ii) to grant exemption for the cladding to project over street provided that CBS/HKE was satisfied with the further justification to be submitted

by the AP on the need to have the cladding projected over the street.

(e) BCI 3 23/2006

Issue : Conversion of an existing commercial building into hotel with hotel

concession under B(P)Reg 23A.

Decision : The committee, having noted that TD had objection to the

non-provision of on-site transport facilities and that the proposal did not comply with the requirements set out in PNAP 111, agreed that the

proposed change of use from office to hotel was unacceptable.
