Summary of Decisions of the Building Committee Building Committee I 29/2007 held on 7.8.2007

(a) MAI 1 29/2007

Issue : Proposed setback be accepted as part of the specified street for site

classification purpose.

Decision : The committee noted that the AP had proposed to setback and

widened one of the streets such that the site would become a corner site abutting three streets having a width of not less than 4.5m. Having studied the case, the committee would have no objection for the site to be classified as a Class C site provided that at least 60% of

its boundary abutted onto the specified streets.

(b) MAI 2 29/2007

Issue : (i) Acceptance of a headroom of 5.75m for the entrance foyer.

(ii) Exclusion of voids over the living rooms from GFA calculation.

(iii) Inclusion of uncovered flat roof with high enclosure walls.

Decision: (i) The committee noted that the proposal was to convert an approved lean-to roof having a mean storey height of 5.75 into a flat roof. Having noted the history of the case and having studied the design, the committee raised no objection to the

revised design of the entrance foyer.

(ii) Having heard the AP's presentation in the meeting and noting that the AP was willing to provide landscape layout plan and visual simulation for the proposed voids and the garden above, the committee reserved a decision pending further information

from the AP.

(iii) Having studied the design, the committee agreed that the enclosed flat roof should count for GFA.

(c) MAI 3 29/2007

Issue : Application for hotel concession for alteration and addition works to

the two existing hotels under B(P)Reg 23A.

Decision : The committee noted that the proposal was in compliance with the

criteria set out in PNAP 111 and that the development had been reassessed and was in accordance with the current PNAP. The committee also noted there was no objection from the relevant outside departments. Hence, the committee agreed to grant hotel concession

under B(P)Reg 23A.

(d) BCI 1 29/2007

Issue : Application for hotel concession for a conversion from

office/commercial building to hotel under B(P)Reg 23A.

Decision : The committee, having noted the proposal was in compliance with the

requirements set out in PNAP 111 and TD had no objection to the non-provision of on-site transport facilities, agreed to grant hotel

concession under B(P)Reg 23A.

(e) <u>BCI 2 29/2007</u>

Issue : Shop extension to the rear yards of one of the building blocks

approved under "Volume Regulation".

Decision : Having noted that the PR would not exceed the permissible under the

First Schedule, the committee agreed to grant a technical modification to permit the existing domestic site coverage on upper floors to

exceed the permissible under the B(P)Reg.

(f) <u>BCI 3 29/2007</u>

Issue : Planning application for a hotel development on a R(A) zone.

Decision : Having heard the advice of the CBS on the application, the committee

agreed to advise PlanD that there was no objection in principle to the hotel proposal under BO while the development intensity would be

left to the decision of PlanD/TPB.
