Summary of Decisions of the Building Committee Building Committee I 12/2008 held on 26.3.2008

(a) MAI 1 12/2008

Issue : (i) Proposed surrender for road widening public passage in return for bonus PR and SC.

(ii) Inclusion of the existing rear lane into site area.

Decision : (i) The committee noted that the proposed road widening was in

line with the road widening scheme. The committee also noted that there was no adverse comment from the relevant departments on the proposed claim for bonus in principle. Hence the committee agreed to grant bonus in return for the proposed surrender. In this regard it was noted that the portion of the area proposed for surrender was subject to a ROW. As LandsD would not accept surrender of land subject to encumbrances, the AP was therefore asked to explore the feasibility for the extinguishment of the concerned ROW.

(ii) The committee noted that subject to the AP's proposed widening of the side lane, the subject rear lane would not be a required lane under the BO. Having noted that there was no objection from other outside departments, the committee agreed to the inclusion of said lane into site area in line with PNAP 179.

(b) BCI 1 12/2008

Issue : Formal appeal against disapproval of a building plans on

contravention of OZP.

Decision: Having considered all relevant factors, the committee agreed to

contest the appeal.

(c) <u>BCI 2 12/2008</u>

Issue : Footbridge projecting over street.

Decision : The committee noted that the AP had not provided sufficient

information on how a public passageway could be guarantee in the building to which the footbridge was to be connected to. Hence the committee deferred a decision pending further information from the

AP.

(d) BCI 3 12/2008

Issue : Exclusion of the areas covered by green balcony and utility platform

from GFA calculation.

Decision : The committee, having noted that the covered flat roof areas were

open on at least two sides and that the 8% cap set out under the JPN would not be exceeded if the said covered areas were counted as green

balconies, agreed to exclude such areas from GFA calculation.

(e) BCI 4 12/2008

Issue : Exclusion of covered walkways at podium level of a commercial

complex from GFA calculation.

Decision : Having considered the design and the background of the case, the

committee did not agree to exclude the covered walkways from GFA

due to their excessive size.

(f) BCI 5 12/2008

Issue : Application for hotel concession.

Decision : The committee, having noted that the proposal was generally in

compliance with the criteria set out in PNAP 111, agreed to grant hotel concession under B(P)Reg 23A subject to no adverse comment from

TD.

(g) <u>BCI 6 12/2008</u>

Issue : Exclusion of voids over living rooms in duplex units.

Decision : The committee, having studied the design, had no objection to the

exclusion of the voids from GFA calculation.
