Summary of Decisions of the Building Committee Building Committee I 31/2008 held on 5.8.2008

(a) MAI 1 31/2008

Issue : Proposed single family house on a site not abutting a street of not less

than 4.5m wide.

Decision : Subject to demonstration on the adequacy on the provision of

vehicular services to the proposal and justification that there was no adverse impact on the cumulative effect arising from the increase in development intensity and subject to acceptance of the same under the lease conditions, the proposed development parameters of plot ratio 0.902, site coverage 37.275% and building height 15.45m were

accepted in principle under B(P)Reg 19(3).

(b) BCI 1 31/2008

Issue : Exclusion of RC sunshades above the bay windows from GFA

calculations.

Decision : The committee, having heard the AP's presentation and having agreed

that the sunshades would contribute to environment, agreed to exclude such features from GFA calculation subject to AP's clarification that the features would be physically separated from the bay windows.

(c) <u>BCI 2 31/2008</u>

Issue : Application for hotel concession.

Decision : The committee noted that the proposal was generally in compliance

with the criteria set out in PNAP 111 and that no objection from the relevant outside departments. Hence, the committee agreed to the

granting of hotel concession under B(P)Reg 23A.

(d) BCI 3 31/2008

Issue : Application for hotel concession for a conversion project from

commercial building to hotel

Decision : The committee noted that the proposal was generally in compliance

with the criteria set out in PNAP 111 and that TD had no objection to the non-provision of on-site transport facilities. Hence, the committee agreed to the granting of hotel concession under B(P)Reg

23A.

(e) <u>BCI 4 31/2008</u>

Issue : Proposed single family houses with 3 storeys and a cockloft.

Decision : The committee, having studied the explanatory note of the MOE Code

and having studied the plans, agreed that the proposed buildings were houses having more than 3 main storeys. The committee agreed that

the building should be subject to the code.

(f) BCI 5 31/2008

Issue : Exclusion of architectural features on roof for a school building from

GFA calculation.

Decision : The committee, having considered the design and the use of the

building, accepted the features were genuine design features. Hence, the committee agreed to grant a modification for the exclusion of the

features from GFA calculation.
