# Summary of Decisions of the Building Committee Building Committee I 7/2010 held on 23.2.2010

# (a) MAI 1 7/2010

Issue : Exclusion of underground air-cooling tunnels, air-cooling tubes and

solar chimneys from GFA calculation.

Decision : The committee noted basically the issue was a lease matter. Having

considered all relevant issues, the committee agreed to accept the underground air-cooling tunnels, air-cooling tubes and solar chimneys to be excluded from GFA calculation under B(P)Reg 23(3)(b) for the

purpose of the BO.

## (b) BCI 1 7/2010

Issue : Disapproval of building plans under BOs 16(1)(h).

Decision : Having considered TD's advice that the proposed run-in/out was not

acceptable, the committee agreed to reject the plans under BO

s.16(1)(h).

## (c) BCI 2 7/2010

Issue : Disapproval of building plans for vehicular access arrangement not

found acceptable under BO s16(1)(h).

Decision : Having considered TD's advice, the committee agreed to invoke BO

s.16(1)(i) requiring further information to address the concern of TD

while reserving position under sec 16(1)(h) of the BO.

## (d) <u>BCI 3 7/2010</u>

Issue : Disapproval of building plans for vehicular access arrangement not

found acceptable under BOs 16(1)(h).

Decision : Having considered TD's advice, the committee agreed to invoke BO

s.16(1)(i) requiring further information to address the concern of TD

while reserving position under sec 16(1)(h) of the BO.

#### (e) BCI 4 7/2010

Issue : Proposed surrender of setback for road widening in return for bonus

PR and SC.

Decision : Having noted that the proposed setback was required for road

widening by the government, the committee agreed to the granting of

bonus PR and SC in return for the surrender.

# (f) BCI 5 7/2010

Issue : Extension of lift shaft on the roof and alteration works within a

building approved under "Volume Regulations".

Decision : Having noted that the works would not constitute any changes in the

existing PR and SC, the committee agreed to grant a technical modification to permit the existing SC and PR to exceed the

permissible under the B(P)Reg.

# (g) <u>BCI 6 7/2010</u>

Issue : (i) Application for excessive non-domestic site coverage in accordance with PNAP APP-132.

(ii) Exclusion of void over entrance lobby from GFA calculation.

(iii) Exclusion of the voids over the living room of the duplex units from GFA calculation.

Decision : (i) Noting that the proposal was in compliance with the criteria set out in PNAP APP-132 and there was no adverse comment from

other departments, the committee agreed to grant a modification

to permit excessive site coverage.

(ii) The committee, having studied the design, agreed to the

exclusion of the void from GFA calculation in principle.

(iii) Having studied the design, the committee did not agree to the

exclusion of the voids from GFA calculation.

#### (h) BCI 7 7/2010

Issue : Proposed single family house on a site not abutting a street of not less

than 4.5m wide.

Decision : Having noted that the proposal was not in line with development

parameters set out in the Layout Plan, the committee did not agree to

the proposed development intensity.

## (i) <u>BCI 8 7/2010</u>

Issue : Disapproval of plan under BO s16(1)(g).

Decision: Having studied the case, the committee asked for additional

information and deferred a decision.
