# Summary of Decisions of the Building Committee Building Committee I 21/2010 held on 1.6.2010

### (a) BCI 1 21/2010

Issue : Inclusion of lane into site area.

Decision : The committee, having noted that the lane was not a required lane

under the BO and that it would not be built over, agreed to the

inclusion of the lane in site area in line with PNAP APP-73.

### (b) BCI 2 21/2010

Issue : Exclusion of covered area under 1/F canopy from GFA calculation.

Decision : Having studied the plans, the committee noted that the covered area

had a local function and should be included in GFA calculation. Hence the committee did not agree to the exclusion of the covered area

from GFA calculation.

## (c) <u>BCI 3 21/2010</u>

Issue : (i) Exclusion of voids over G/F shop entrance and main office lift lobby from GFA calculation.

- (ii)(a) Exclusion of covered area under 1/F canopy from GFA calculation.
- (ii)(b) Exclusion of voids around and above escalators at the main entrance from GFA calculation.
- (iii) High headroom over lift lobby and banking hall for a commercial building.

Decision : (i) The committee, having considered the design, did not agree to the exclusion of the voids from GFA calculation.

- (ii)(a) Having studied the plans, the committee noted that the covered area had a local function and should be included in GFA calculation. Hence the committee did not agree to the exclusion of the covered area from GFA calculation.
- (ii)(b) The committee, having studied the design, agreed to the exclusion of the voids from GFA calculation.
- (iii) Having considered the genuine design of the lift lobby and banking hall, the committee agreed to accept the proposed headroom.

## (d) BCI 4 21/2010

Issue : Application for hotel concession.

Decision : The committee noted that the proposal was generally in compliance

with the criteria set out in PNAP APP-40 and that there was no objection from relevant outside departments. Hence, the committee

agreed to the granting of hotel concession under B(P)Reg 23A.

# (e) <u>BCI 5 21/2010</u>

Issue : Dedication for public passage in return for GFA exemption.

Decision : Noting that the AP would consider the provision of facilities for barrier

free access, the committee agreed to defer a decision.
