Summary of Decisions of the Building Committee Building Committee I 35/2010 held on 7.9.2010

(a) MAI 1 35/2010

Issue : (i) Proposed single-family house on a site abutting a street of less than 4.5m wide.

(ii) Exclusion of void over living room from GFA calculation.

Decision : (i) The committee noted that the proposed development parameters

were generally in line with the OZP and Layout Plan. Having considered all relevant factors and that there was no objection from relevant outside departments, the committee raised no objection to the proposal under B(P)Reg 19(3). The AP's attention was drawn to BO s14(2) on the compliance with lease

requirements.

(ii) The committee, having studied the design, had no objection to

the exclusion of the void from GFA calculation.

(b) MAI 2 35/2010

Issue : Formal appeal against BA's disapproval of plans.

Decision : Having considered the case, the committee agreed to contest the

appeal.

(c) BCI 1 35/2010

Issue : Exclusion of sunshades from GFA calculation.

Decision : The committee, having noted that the sunshades were in line with the

criteria stipulated in JPN 1 and that there was no objection from other relevant departments, agreed to exclude the said sunshades from GFA

calculation.

(d) <u>BCI 2 35/2010</u>

Issue : Application for hotel concession.

Decision : The committee noted that the proposal was generally in compliance

with the criteria set out in PNAP APP-40 and that there was no objection from relevant outside departments. Hence, the committee

agreed to the granting of hotel concession under B(P)Reg 23A.

(e) BCI 3 35/2010

Issue : (i) Excessive domestic SC for hostel conversion.

(ii) Deficiency in the provision of open space.

Decision :

- (i) The Committee noted that the proposal did not involve an increase of building height and that the proposed PR would comply with the statutory limits. Having considered the special circumstances and that there was no objection from relevant outside departments, the Committee agreed in-principle to permit excessive SC under B(P)Reg 20.
- (ii) Having considered the special circumstances and that the natural lighting and ventilation of habitable accommodation would not be adversely affected, the Committee agreed in-principle to accept the deficiency in the provision of open space under B(P)Reg 25.
