(a) MAI 1 26/2011

Issue : Proposed dedication of setback for public passage.

Decision : Having studied the plans and the advice from relevant outside

departments, the committee did not accept the proposed dedication.

(b) <u>MAI 2 26/2011</u>

Issue : Exclusion of architectural feature from GFA & SC calculations.

Decision : Having considered the feature was a genuine design feature, the

committee agreed to the exclusion of it from GFA & SC calculations.

(c) <u>BCI 1 26/2011</u>

Issue : Shop extension to the yard area of a building approved under the then

building regulations.

Decision : Having noted that the PR would not exceed the permissible under the

First Schedule, the committee agreed to the granting of technical modification to permit the existing domestic site coverage on upper

floors to exceed the permissible under the B(P)Rs.

(d) <u>BCI 2 26/2011</u>

Issue : (i) Topographical feature under building separation requirement.

(ii) Means of escape passing through loading and unloading area.

(iii) Exclusion of a portion of footbridge within private lot from GFA

and SC calculations.

Decision: (i) Having studied the proposal, the committee agreed that it was premature to consider disregarding a topographical feature under building separation requirement in the absence of justifications.

(ii) Having considered the case, the committee agreed that it was premature to consider the application in the absence of justifications.

(iii) Having studied the proposal, the committee did not agree to the exclusion of footbridge within private lot from GFA and SC calculations.

(e) BCI 3 26/2011

Formal appeals against disapproval of plans. Issue
