# **Summary of Decisions of the Building Committee Building Committee I 45/2011 held on 8.11.2011**

### (a) MAI 1 45/2011

Issue : Structure projecting over right of way.

Decision : Having considered the proposals and noted that there was no objection

from relevant outside departments, the committee accepted the

proposed structure projecting over right of way.

# (b) <u>BCI 1 45/2011</u>

Issue : Proposed development on a site not abutting a 4.5m wide street.

Decision : The committee noted that there was no objection from relevant outside

departments. Having considered all relevant factors, the committee

agreed the development intensity under B(P)R 19(3).

### (c) <u>BCI 2 45/2011</u>

Issue : (i) Areas to be formed for future public roads.

(ii) Area over government land as a specified street.

Decision : (i) Having noted the site situation and the advice of a relevant

government department, the committee accepted the areas as

parts of a specified street under B(P)R 18A.

(ii) The committee did not accept the area over government land as a

specified street as the criteria under B(P)R 18A were not

satisfied.

## (d) BCI 3 45/2011

Issue : Exclusion of void from GFA calculation in an institutional building.

Decision : The committee, having studied the proposal, agreed to exclude the

void from GFA calculation.

### (e) BCI 4 45/2011

Issue : Height of storey in a house development.

Decision : Having noted the advice of relevant outside departments and that the

proposed height of storey was excessive, the committee did not accept

the proposal.

## (f) BCI 5 45/2011

Issue : Building height of a commercial development.

Decision : Having studied the history of the case, and noted the advice of relevant

outside departments, the committee raised no objection to the

proposed building height.

# (g) <u>BCI 6 45/2011</u>

Issue : Increase of GFA on a site not abutting a specified street of 4.5m wide.

Decision : The committee noted that the proposal was generally in line with the

OZP and that there was no objection from relevant outside departments. Having considered all relevant factors, the committee

agreed to the proposed development intensity under B(P)R 19(3).

# (h) <u>BCI 7 45/2011</u>

Issue : Formal appeal against disapproval of plans.

Decision : Having considered the case, the committee agreed to contest the

appeal.
