Summary of Decisions of the Building Committee Building Committee I 48/2012 held on 11.12.2012

(a) MAI 1 48/2012

Issue : Exclusion of covered pedestrian link from GFA calculation.

Decision : Having studied the proposal and considered the advice of relevant

outside departments, the committee raised no in-principle objection to exclusion of the covered pedestrian link from GFA calculation subject

to revised design.

(b) <u>BCI 1 48/2012</u>

Issue : Exclusion of voids in single-family houses from GFA calculation.

Decision : Noting that the criteria set out in Appendix A of PNAP APP-2 were

complied with, the committee agreed to the exclusion of the voids from GFA calculation. The committee also agreed that the AP should be reminded of the provision of BO s14(2) regarding

compliance with the lease conditions.

(c) BCI 2 48/2012

Issue : (i) Proposed development on a site not provided with an access

from a street.

(ii) Development intensity for a site not abutting a specified street.

Decision : Noting that the site was accessible from an existing footpath, the

proposal was generally in line with the OZP, and there was no objection from relevant outside departments, the committee had no objection to the proposal under B(P)Rs 5 and 19(3). The committee also agreed that the AP should be reminded of the provision of BO

s14(2) regarding compliance with the lease conditions.

(d) BCI 3 48/2012

Issue : Validity period of modification / exemption.

Decision : The committee was unable to identify any genuine technical

difficulties which justify the extension of time and did not agree to

extend the validity period.

(e) <u>BCI 4 48/2012</u>

Issue : Proposed surrender and setback for road widening in return for bonus

PR and SC.

Decision : Having studied the proposal and considered the advice of relevant

outside departments, the committee considered that further information was required before further consideration of the

application.

(f) <u>BCI 5 48/2012</u>

Issue : Exclusion of projecting signboard within lot boundary from GFA

calculation.

Decision : Having studied the proposal and considered the relevant criteria under

PNAP APP-126, the committee did not agree to exclude the projecting

signboard within lot boundary from GFA calculation.
