Summary of Decisions of the Building Committee Building Committee I 11/2013 held on 19.3.2013

(a) MAI 1 11/2013

Issue : Site not abutting a specified street.

Decision : Noting that the proposal was generally in line with the approved

planning schemes, the committee had no in-principle objection to the proposal under B(P)R 5 and agreed to the proposed development intensity under B(P)R 19(3), subject to further substantiation that the site would be accessible from a street via an unfettered right-of-way.

(b) BCI 1 11/2013

Issue : Determination of site classification.

Decision : Having regard to the site circumstances, the committee had no

objection in principle to the proposed site classification.

(c) BCI 2 11/2013

Issue : (i) Exclusion of vertical greening from GFA calculation.

(ii) Exclusion of precast concrete loss formwork with finishes from

GFA and site coverage calculations.

Decision : (i) Having studied the design, the committee agreed to exclude the

proposed vertical greening from GFA calculation.

(ii) The committee accepted that the proposed concrete loss formwork resembled external wall finishes. In line with PNAP APP-2, the committee agreed to disregard the proposed

loss formwork from GFA and site coverage calculations.

(d) BCI 3 11/2013

Issue : Application for hotel concession.

Decision : Noting that the proposal generally complied with the criteria set out in

PNAP APP-40, and there was no objection from concerned departments, the committee agreed to the granting of hotel concession

under B(P)R 23A subject to revised design of BOH facilities.

(e) <u>BCI 4 11/2013</u>

Issue : Validity period of modification / exemption.

Decision

Having considered the AP's justifications and the genuine technical difficulty in obtaining the consent for the commencement of the relevant building works before the expiry of the two-year time limit, the committee agreed to extend the validity period.

(f) <u>BCI 5 11/2013</u>

Issue : (i) Non-compliance with the building separation requirements on

continuous projected facade length (Lp) and permeability (P)

for structures at low zone.

(ii) Refuge roofs cum greenery area.

(iii) Discharge of exit routes onto greenery areas on G/F.

Decision : (i) Noting that the existing structures were completed before

implementation of the SBD Guidelines, the committee had no in-principle objection to the proposal subject to further

supplementary information.

(ii) Noting that the proposal was similar to the case of a refuge

floor cum sky garden, the committee had no in-principle

objection to the proposal subject to revised design.

(iii) Having studied the proposal, the committee had no objection to the proposed means of escape subject to the provision of

hard-paved footpaths.

(g) <u>BCI 6 11/2013</u>

Issue : Application for hotel concession.

Decision : Noting that the proposal generally complied with the criteria set out in

PNAP APP-40, and there was no objection from concerned departments, the committee agreed to the granting of hotel concession

under B(P)R 23A subject to revised design.

(h) BCI 7 11/2013

Issue : Exclusion of covered landscaped and pavement areas on G/F and 1/F

from GFA calculation.

Decision : Having studied the design, the committee agreed to exclude the subject

covered areas from GFA calculation subject to no objection from

concerned departments.

(i) BCI 8 11/2013

Issue : (i) Exclusion of stone cladding from site coverage and GFA calculations.

(ii) Exclusion of vertical greening from site coverage and GFA calculations.

Decision : (i) Having studied the design, the committee agreed to exclude the proposed stone cladding from site coverage and GFA calculations.

(ii) Having studied the design, the committee agreed to exclude the proposed vertical greening from site coverage and GFA calculations.
