# **Summary of Decisions of the Building Committee Building Committee I 22/2013 held on 4.6.2013**

## (a) MAI 1 22/2013

Issue : Proposed single-family houses on a site not abutting a specified street.

Decision : Noting that the site was accessible from an existing road, the

committee had no in-principle objection to the proposal under B(P)R 5 and agreed to the proposed development intensity under B(P)R 19(3),

subject to no adverse comments from concerned departments.

## (b) BCI 1 22/2013

Issue : Development intensity of a site not abutting on a specified street of not

less than 4.5m wide.

Decision : Noting that the proposed development intensity was in line with the

OZP and that there was no objection from relevant outside departments, the committee had no in-principle objection to the

proposed development intensity under B(P)R 19(3).

# (c) <u>BCI 2 22/2013</u>

Issue : Extinguishment, building over and inclusion in site area of an existing

track and access road.

Decision : Noting that a diverted track and access road would be provided and

relevant outside departments had no adverse comments on the proposal, the committee raised no objection to the proposed extinguishment, building upon and inclusion in site area of the existing

track and access road within the site.

## (d) BCI 3 22/2013

Issue : Application for hotel concession.

Decision : Noting that the proposal generally complied with the criteria set out in

PNAP APP-40, and there was no objection from concerned departments, the committee agreed to the granting of hotel concession

under B(P)R 23A.

#### (e) BCI 4 22/2013

Issue : Validity period of modification / exemption.

Decision : Having considered the AP's justifications and the genuine technical

difficulty in obtaining the consent for the commencement of the relevant building works before the expiry of the two-year time limit,

the committee agreed to extend the validity period.

# (f) <u>BCI 5 22/2013</u>

Issue : Application for flexible application of domestic site coverage under

PNAP APP-132.

Decision : Noting that the proposal generally complied with the criteria set out in

PNAP APP-132, the committee agreed to grant a modification to

permit flexible application of site coverage.
