# Summary of Decisions of the Building Committee Building Committee I 50/2013 held on 17.12.2013

# (a) MAI 1 50/2013

Issue : Validity period of modification / exemption.

Decision : Having considered the AP's justifications and the genuine technical

difficulties in obtaining the consent for the commencement of the relevant building works before the expiry of the two-year time limit,

the committee agreed to extend the validity period.

# (b) <u>BCI 1 50/2013</u>

Issue : Exclusion of rainwater recycling plant room from GFA calculations.

Decision: Having considered the design and the function of the proposed

rainwater recycling system, the committee agreed to exclude the plant

room from GFA calculations.

## (c) BCI 2 50/2013

Issues : (i) Headroom of a PPE.

(ii) Headroom of a shopping arcade and associated uses.

Decisions : (i) Having studied the design, the committee had no objection to

the proposed headroom.

(ii) Having studied the design, the committee had no objection to

the proposed headroom.

### (d) BCI 3 50/2013

Issue : Exclusion of refuse storage and material recovery rooms from GFA

calculations.

Decision : Having studied the proposal, the committee considered that further

justifications were required to exclude the refuse storage and material

recovery rooms from GFA calculations.

# (e) BCI 4 50/2013

Issues : (i) Exclusion of rainwater recycling plant rooms from GFA calculations.

(ii) Exclusion of vertical greenery structure from GFA calculations.

Decisions: (i) Having considered the design and the function of the proposed rainwater recycling system, the committee agreed to exclude the plant rooms from GFA calculations subject to revised design.

(ii) Having studied the design, the committee agreed to exclude the vertical greenery structure from GFA calculations.

### (f) <u>BCI 5 50/2013</u>

Issues : (i) Compliance with PNAP APP-151.

(ii) Exclusion of voids from GFA calculations.

(iii) Exclusion of atrium voids from GFA calculations.

Decisions : (i) Having regard to the circumstances of the case, the committee agreed that PNAP APP-151 was applicable to the proposal.

(ii) Having studied the proposal, the committee agreed to exclude the voids from GFA calculations subject to further justifications.

(iii) Noting that the voids were genuine design features and there were no objection from relevant departments, the committee agreed to exclude the voids from GFA calculations.
