# Summary of Decisions of the Building Committee Building Committee I 9/2015 held on 10.3.2015

#### (a) MAI 1 9/2015

Issue : Flexible application of site coverage.

Decision : The committee considered that the proposal was not in line with the

spirit of PNAP APP-132 and did not agree to permit the flexible

application of site coverage.

# (b) MAI 2 9/2015

Issue : Exclusion of void from GFA calculations.

Decision : Having regard to the design and functional use of the concerned area,

the committee agreed to exclude the void from GFA calculations.

#### (c) BCI 1 9/2015

Issue : Validity period of modification / exemption.

Decision : Having considered the AP's justifications, the committee agreed to

extend the validity period.

#### (d) <u>BCI 2 9/2015</u>

Issues : (i) Proposed means of access to a site.

(ii) Development intensities and building height for a site not

abutting a specified street of not less than 4.5m wide.

Decision : The committee considered that further substantiations on the proposed

site access and development intensities were required and agreed that it was premature to consider the proposal under B(P)Rs 5 and 19(3).

# (e) <u>BCI 3 9/2015</u>

Issues : GFA calculations for a special curtain wall design.

Decisions : Having studied the proposal, the committee had no objection to the

proposed method of calculating the GFA.

# (f) BCI 4 9/2015

Issue : Building to be erected over, in and under a street.

Decision : Noting that there were no adverse comments from concerned

departments, the committee agreed to the proposed building over, in

and under a street.

# (g) BCI 5 9/2015

Issue : Application for hotel concession.

Decision : Noting that the proposal generally met the criteria set out in PNAP

APP-40 and that there was no objection from concerned departments, the committee had no in-principle objection to the granting of hotel

concession under B(P)R 23A subject to revised design.

#### (h) <u>BCI 6 9/2015</u>

Issue : Exclusion of rainwater recycling plant rooms from GFA calculations.

Decision : Having considered the design and the function of the proposed

rainwater recycling system, the committee agreed to exclude the plant

rooms from GFA calculations.
