Summary of Decisions of the Building Committee Building Committee I 34/2015 held on 22.9.2015

(a) MAI 1 34/2015

Issues (i) Proposed footbridge projecting over a street.

> (ii) Exclusion of covered area for public passage from GFA calculations.

Decisions

- Noting that the proposal generally met the criteria under PNAP (i) APP-38, the committee had no in-principle objection to the proposed footbridge projecting over a street subject to acceptance of the same by the ACABAS and concerned departments, and further substantiations.
- (ii) Having studied the proposal, the committee had no objection to the exclusion of the covered area for public passage from GFA calculations.

(b) BCI 1 34/2015

Issue Proposed footbridge projecting over a street.

Decision Noting that the proposal was considered acceptable by the ACABAS :

> and there were no adverse comments from concerned departments, the committee agreed to the proposed footbridge projecting over a street.

(c) BCI 2 34/2015

Issues (i) Proposed means of access to a site.

> (ii) Development intensity and building height for a site not abutting

a specified street of not less than 4.5m wide.

Decision Noting that the site would be accessible from a specified street and an

existing access road which was properly formed and paved with permission from the owner and there were no adverse comments from concerned departments, the committee had no objection to the proposal under B(P)R 5 and the proposed development intensity and

building height under B(P)R 19(3).

(d) BCI 3 34/2015

GFA calculations for a special façade design. **Issues**

Decisions Having studied the proposal, the committee had no objection to the

proposed GFA calculation method.

(e) BCI 4 34/2015

Issue : Exclusion of rainwater recycling plant room from GFA calculations.

Decision : Having considered the design and the function of the proposed

rainwater recycling system, the committee agreed to exclude the plant

room from GFA calculations.

(f) BCI 5 34/2015

Issue : Proposed dedication for public passage in return for bonus PR and SC.

Decision : Having regard to the circumstances of the case and the advice of

concerned departments, the committee had no objection to the granting

of bonus PR and SC in return for the proposed dedication.
