# Summary of Decisions of the Building Committee Building Committee I 9/2019 held on 12.3.2019

#### (a) MAI 1 9/2019

Issue : Proposed high headroom of testing, training and demonstration areas.

Decision : Having considered the design and the use of the building and having

noted that there was no objection from the relevant departments, the committee agreed in principle that the proposed clear headroom would

be favourably considered upon building plan submission.

## (b) MAI 2 9/2019

Issue : Development intensities and building height for a site not abutting on a

specified street of not less than 4.5m wide.

Decision : Having regard to the circumstances of the case, the committee

accepted in principle the proposed development intensities and building height under B(P)R 19(3) subject to no adverse comment

from other relevant departments.

## (c) BCI 1 9/2019

Issue : Application for hotel concession.

Decision : Noting that the proposal generally met the criteria set out in PNAP

APP-40 and no adverse comment from relevant departments, the committee had no objection to grant hotel concession under B(P)R

23A.

#### (d) BCI 2 9/2019

Issue : Surrender of land for road widening in return for bonus plot ratio and

site coverage.

Decision : Noting that there was no objection from concerned departments, the

committee agreed to grant bonus plot ratio and site coverage in return

for the proposed surrender of land.

### (e) <u>BCI 3 9/2019</u>

Issues : (i) Development intensities and building height for a site not

abutting on a specified street of not less than 4.5m wide.

(ii) Exclusion of void over the fover from GFA calculations.

Decisions : (i) Having regard to the circumstances of the case, the committee

accepted in principle the proposed development intensities and building height under B(P)R 19(3) subject to no adverse

comment from other relevant departments.

(ii) Noting the design of the void generally met the criteria set out in Appendix A to PNAP APP-2 and no adverse comment from relevant departments, the committee agreed to exclude the void from GFA calculations.

# (f) <u>BCI 4 9/2019</u>

Issue : Exclusion of rainwater recycling plant room from GFA calculations.

Decision : Having considered the design and the function of the proposed

rainwater recycling system, the committee had no objection to exclude

the relevant plant room from GFA calculations.
