Summary of Decisions of the Building Committee Building Committee I 35/2022 held on 5.10.2022

- (a) <u>BCI 1 35/2022</u>
 - Issues : (i) Architectural features on roofs and horizontal and vertical architectural fins on external walls.
 - (ii) Exclusion of internal public pedestrian walkways from GFA calculation.
 - (iii) Exclusion of public pedestrian passages adjoining public streets from GFA calculation.
 - (iv) Exclusion of covered public passageways from GFA calculation.
 - Decisions : (i) Having considered the design, the committee accepted the exclusion of the roof areas covered by architectural features and horizontal and vertical architectural fins from GFA calculations.
 - (ii) Having regard to the circumstances of the case, the committee agreed to exempt the pedestrian walkways from GFA calculation.
 - (iii) Having regard to the circumstances of the case, the committee agreed to exempt the pedestrian passages from GFA calculation.
 - (iv) Having studied the proposal and the AP's justifications, the committee agreed to defer the decision pending for further justifications to be provided for consideration.
- (b) <u>BCI 2 35/2022</u>
 - Issue : Rectangular horizontal plane of prescribed windows protruding beyond lot boundary over the adjoining slope.
 - Decision : Having regard to the circumstances of the case, the committee agreed the proposed prescribed windows provision.
- (c) <u>BCI 3 35/2022</u>
 - Issues : (i) Proposed means of access to a site.
 - (ii) Development intensities and building height for a site not abutting on a specified street.
 - Decisions : (i) Noting that the sites would be accessible from a specified street through an existing access road on government land, the committee had no objection to the proposed means of access under B(P)R 5.

(ii) Having regard to the circumstances of the case, the committee accepted in-principle the proposed development intensities and building height under B(P)R 19(3) subject to no adverse comments from relevant departments.
