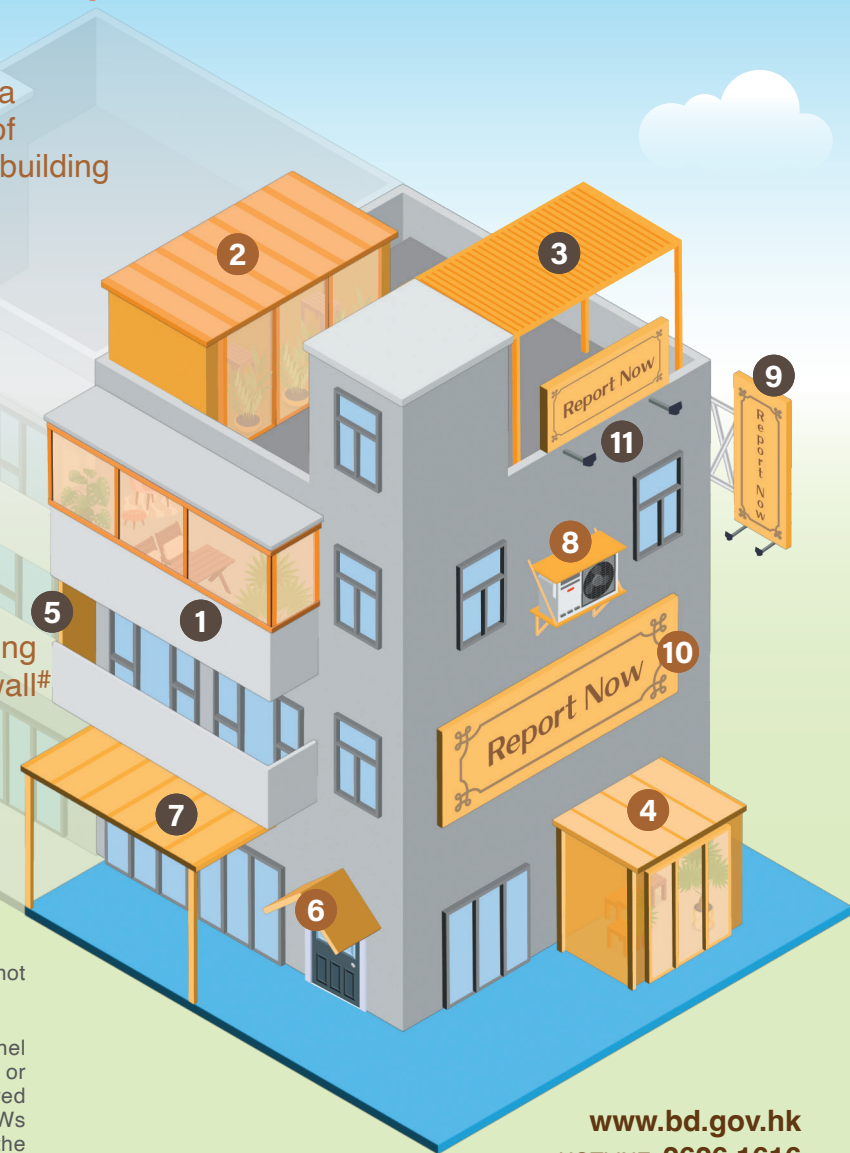
Existing Unauthorised Building Works (UBWs) eligible for the Reporting Scheme

(Refer to UBWs completed before 28 June 2011)

- 1 Enclosed balcony
- 2 Enclosed rooftop structures with a coverage of not more than 50% of the roofed-over area of the main building
- 3 Unenclosed rooftop structures
- 4 Ground floor extension
- 5 Partition wall exceeding 150mm in thickness erected between the balconies of two adjoining village houses
- 6 Canopy projecting from an external wall#
- 7 Ground floor canopy with pillars
- 8 Metal supporting rack and lightweight hood for air-conditioning unit projecting from an external wall#
- 9 Signboard projecting from an external wall
- 10 Wall signboard mounted on an external wall#
- 11 Signboard erected on a rooftop

The allowed green and amenity facilities are not required to be reported.

Owners are required to appoint qualified personnel (Technically Competent Person of Grade T2 or above/Registered Structural Engineer/Registered Professional Engineer as appropriate) to report UBWs in New Territories Exempted Houses eligible for the Reporting Scheme. The appointed qualified personnel are required to complete the electronic reporting form and submit the required information on the relevant UBWs and the administrative fee.
