
# Layman's Guide on Rectifying Defective Drainage System at External Wall

## Receive drainage order

Read the order carefully\*







 Owner to ask RC for a copy of the certificate of completion of works submitted to BD



## Appoint registered contractor (RC)

- Ascertain the category of minor works
- Select RC of the respective category
- Obtain and compare quotations and scope of services (including maintenance period and insurance terms)
- Visit the Buildings Department (BD)'s website for cost information for re-provision of anti-syphonage pipe at external wall for watercloset

Lists of registered professionals or contractors



Cost information for re-provision of anti-syphonage pipe at external wall for watercloset



### **Acknowledge completion**

- BD to issue a letter acknowledging compliance/discharge of the order
- Owner to contact the RC for follow-up action if a rejection letter is received



# Anti-syphonage pipe should be erected at the top side of the branch drainage pipe using a proper connection fitting and located as close to the trap outlet of the watercloset as possible.
